2022 CSF/CMP Excellence In Competition Small Arms Championship

DATE: September 11th, 2022.

LOCATION: Cascade Shooting Facilities outdoor Range E and D at the King County Shooting Sports

Park. 26520 292nd Ave SE Ravensdale, Washington.

RULES: Current CMP rules will govern.

ARMS: .22 Rimfire Pistol, rule 4.1.6 Pistol, rules 4.1. Rifle, rule 4.1.4, U.S. Rifle, Caliber .30, M1. Rifle, rule 4.1.3 U.S. Rifle, Caliber 7.62 NATO (.308), M14. Rifle, rule 4.1.1, U.S. Rifle, Caliber 5.56mm (.223), M16. All pistols & Rifles will be checked to ensure that all safety features are operating properly and the trigger pull is at least 2 lbs for .22 rimfire, 4 lbs. for service pistol, and 4-1/2 lbs. for service rifle. It is the competitor's responsibility to have this check accomplished prior to the match.

CATEGORIES:

OPEN TO: All High-Power and Pistol competitors. The public is welcome to participate. Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement form (attached) must be completed and submitted to the statistical officer <u>before</u> shooting the CMP EIC Leg Matches. If you have previously completed one of these forms, submit a copy of your previously completed form. Form must be <u>notarized</u>.

ENTRY: Entries will be limited to a maximum of 30 competitors.

Priority will be given to non-distinguished shooters. \$60.00 entry fee (\$20 rimfire, \$20 pistol, \$20 rifle). Juniors \$45 (\$15 rimfire, \$15 pistol, \$15 rifle). No voucher's or NRA award points.

TIME: Registration 0800-0900. Firing begins at 0900.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used. Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master class

TARGETS: Cascade Shooting Facilities prone matches will ordinarily use Electronic targets, and the NMC/RMC matches will ordinarily use manually scored targets. However, situations may arise that changes the normal procedures.

AWARDS: Rifle & Pistol EIC points will be awarded to the top 10% in respective rifle & pistol matches. Bronze, silver and gold Achievement pins will also be awarded.

PULLING TARGETS: Competitors will pull targets or provide their own puller. Competitors will be held responsible for contracted pullers.

MATCH COURSE:

Match 1: CMP .22 Rimfire Pistol EIC Match, National Match Course, 30 shots

Match 2: CMP Service Pistol EIC Match, National Match Course, 30 shots

Match 3: CMP Service Rifle EIC Match, National Match Course, 50 shots

Match 4: "Small Arms" Champion, Aggregate of Matches 1-3.
