- The BOD made an emergency approval vote to purchase a safe to store the firearms and equipment received from Steve Podleski's estate. The purchase price for the safe was \$5,740.00. The board voted unanimously to approve the purchase.

New Business

Ken Littlefield – September 2023 CSF Bylaw/Operation Procedures Amendment Votes:

Proposal #1: Amendment to Bylaw Article XI, Section 2 – *Voting Procedures*

- This was an amendment to a Bylaw which requires a 2/3 majority of votes cast to be approved.
- The amendment **FAILED** with 13.2% of votes cast in favor.
- 52 YES votes vs. 340 No votes.

Proposal #2: Amendment to Operating Procedure Article II, Section 11, Paragraph C – *Annual Work Requirement Due Date*

- This was an amendment to an Operating Procedure which requires a majority of votes cast to be approved.
- The amendment was **APPROVED** with 85.8% of votes cast in favor.
- 337 YES votes vs. 56 NO votes.

Proposal #3: Amendment to Bylaw Article XI, Section 1 – *General Procedures*

- This was an amendment to a Bylaw which requires a 2/3 majority of votes cast to be approved.
- The amendment was **APPROVED** with 92.8% of votes cast in favor.
- 361 YES votes vs. 28 NO votes.

The approved amendments have become effective as of September 11, 2023.

Omayra Linse – Wreaths for Veteran's Cemetery

- Motion made for funding request to purchase wreaths for veteran's cemetery.
- Motion seconded. Open discussion held regarding costs and quantity to purchase.
- Vote held to approve \$1,700 for wreath purchase. Motion carried.

Dan Chavre – Adopt a Highway Program

- Permission requested to gather information about the program on behalf of CSF.
- Permission granted. Dan will gather information and report back to club regarding viability of entering the program.

Dennis Astell – B Range Handicap Parking Repair

- Request submitted to maintenance to repair the parking spot.

Val Burkhauser – Master Lock Changes

- Motion made to approve funding of \$10,000 to replace all master locks.
- Motion seconded. Open discussion held.
- Motion tabled. Notice of funding request will be email to membership.



Buddy Miller – Clubhouse Exterior Siding and Paint

- Motion made to approve funding of \$40,000 for siding and painting of clubhouse exterior.
- Motion seconded. Open discussion held.
- Motion tabled. Notice of funding request will be email to membership.
