DATE: October 5th, 2024.

LOCATION: Cascade Shooting Facilities outdoor range at the King County Shooting Sports Park. 26520 292nd Ave SE Ravensdale, Washington.

RULES: Current NRA rules will govern.

ARMS: Service Rifle (rule 3.1(c)). Other rifles will be allowed **but will not be eligible for awards.**

CATEGORIES: M16 (AR15) Service Rifle.

OPEN TO: All High-Power competitors. The public is welcome to participate.

ENTRY: This match is limited to 30 competitors. Match fee is \$15.50 + NRA Registration fee is \$4.50 with a total entry fee of \$20. Junior shooters match fee is \$5.50 + NRA Registration fee is \$4.50 with a total entry fee of \$10.

TIME: Registration 0800-0900. Firing begins at 0915.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used. Unclassified competitors will fire in the Master class.

TARGETS: 200 yd SR, 300 yd SR-3, 600 yd MR-1. SR-42 may be used in inclement weather.

AWARDS: Cash awards, rule of 4. Classes may be combined. Match Winner, High Junior, High Woman.

PULLING TARGETS: Cascade Shooting Facilities prone, NMC and RMC matches will use Electronic targets. However, situations may arise that change the normal procedures.

MATCH COURSE

2 sighters + 20 shots for record Standing, 200 yd.

2 sighters, 200 yd.

2 strings of 10 shots for record Rapid Fire Sitting, 200 yd.

2 sighters, 300 yd.

3 sighters, 300 yd.

4 strings of 10 shots for record Rapid Fire Prone, 300 yd.

5 sighters + 20 shots for record Prone, 600 yd.
